

HSA GENERAL MEETING NOVEMBER 15TH, 2018

President Melinda Morgan started the meeting at 8:10 am in the Cafeteria at Harbordale.

Budget - Maryann Cockerille: We have \$61,652.31 in our Budget with \$14,287.68 in Restricted Funds, so we have \$47,364.63 in our account. Under Income in Fundraising we have \$28,021.78 and still have more big fundraisers coming up. Under Expenses in the General Fund we just spent \$6,984.50 (this is because we have done so well in fundraising), and we were able to buy 30 computers for the school. Scholastic News is over budget at \$2,918.26 and we need to raise this. See actual Budget for more details.

Motion: Melinda Morgan made a motion to raise the budget for Scholastic News to \$3,000, Kristi Quarles 2nd the motion, all were in favor so motion passes.

SAF Update, Stephanie Stecker: BSO came in and did a presentation on the Safer Watch App as a way to communicate tips to police. You can set up notifications for your area. Will see if we can put info on this in the red folder.

Principal's Update - Mrs. Bucolo: Mrs. Neal is very sick and she was teacher assistant for about 7 years at our school. She has put an ad for temporary teacher assistant for 7:30-3pm timeframe and no one has responded. Thanked HSA for the new computers which will go to the 5th graders and the older ones will move down. Years ago Harbordale was selected as a D5 (digital 5th grade) school and the District provided computers at the time, but now that has ended so we have to get our own replacements. We purchased iPad cases too. Veterans Day flags are up for about 3 weeks. XMas on Las Olas is November 27th and our 4th-5th graders sing rain or shine. We go on at 6 till about 6:30. Dr. Strauss is out Cadre Director and he's coming to visit tomorrow. Reassignments open on December 3rd. We have traditionally been a heavy reassignment school, but this year we can't be as generous. Limited this year because of the numbers. Ms. Rodriguez's has trained a team of parents for her Great Leaps program to help students out with phonics. Nicki Caruso has spearheaded the Go Fund Me Page and we got the \$5,000 that we needed for the front door buzzer. Mrs. Kashdin is in contact with the District and they are coming out before Thanksgiving to access and it should be a 2-3 months process to get it installed. She went to a Guardian Meeting the other day for all the schools that will be getting them. We still have police officers on campus, but we will be getting a guardian soon. Guardians do carry a gun. Roof & A/C repair/replacement for the old building is coming from the Smart Bond Money. They are coming today to access roof again. Some of the work will happen weekends, holidays, summer and the following summer and it will be a long term project. Carpeting (carpet squares) in the Media Center finally was approved for free. They will start installing Monday night and working evenings through Wednesday, so the Media Center will be closed for a few days.
