Budget - *Maryann Cockerille*: We have \$59,037.69 in our Budget. Restricted Funds is \$11,882.07, so we have \$47,155.62 in our account. The Go Fund Me page still has \$1,728.00 left over after buying the door buzzer. Fundraisers has \$36,886.87, and most are way over budget. Have not received our check for the Walk-a-thon yet. Total Expenses is \$38,056.74. General Funds has \$8,269.10, and this was for computers we bought for the school earlier in the year, and is not in our Budget. See actual Budget for more details.
