Cari Rodriguez - April 26th is the Volunteer Breakfast. She's applying for 5 star status for our school along with some other awards, so please get your Volunteer Logs (hours that haven't been logged in via the Star System) by April 5th.

SAF - Stephanie Streicher: We started a committee to spend the \$100,000 Smart Bond money. She put out feelers on Facebook, and one of the new suggestions was replacing sand on the playgrounds. We're getting estimates for this and shade covering for the PE court. There has to be a \$15,000 difference between the two ballot options, and this requirement comes from the County.

Nominating Committee - Eva Schoop: We are looking for Board Members and Committee Chairs for next year. We need all the volunteers & help we can get. We need a President, Volunteer Coordinator, Merchandise Coordinator, Bulletin Board Coordinator, and potentially a VP of Fundraising. We also need someone to help VP of Membership with data entry.

By Laws - Sandy Stetter: We updated our bylaws and added the position for Campus Beautification. Also a few grammatical errors were updated.

Heal the Planet - Is a non-profit in Broward and on April 14th they are having a Earth Day event. They are offering an affiliate link where our school can get a percentage back from ticket sales. Tickets are \$2.50 in advance, and Broward County students are free. Day of the event is \$5.00. School with the most ticket sales gets awarded \$1,000, 2nd gets \$500, and 3rd gets \$250.

Budget - Maryann Cockerille: We have \$61,345.76 in our account. Out of that, Restricted Funds totals \$11,286.58, so HSA has \$50,059.18 in our account. Bingo Night made \$3,723.00 which is the most we have ever made. We still have Style your Tile and Spring Photos left for Fundraisers. Walkathon money hasn't come in yet, and all the bills are paid on this. Under Expenses, all the Author Assemblies are done and Field Trip Buses are almost done. General Funds is for items like the gardens/landscaping that wasn't budgeted. See actual Budget for details.

Principal's Update - Mrs. Bucolo: FSA testing starts right after we get back from Spring Break. Tuesday, April 2nd is 3rd grade reading, and 4-5th grade writing. Volunteers are not allowed on campus or lunchtime during testing, and we need all the space on campus for this. Testing will be 2 days in April and 6 days in May and is all paper based. The volunteers did a wonderful job on the Campus Beautification project. Chad has been really taking care of all the new landscaping. The first re-assignments are out and we were awarded 20 seats. Kindergarten and new student roundup is April 12th at 9am. Friday April 26th is the Volunteer Breakfast, 5th grade legacy tile and Style your Tile is that night. Garden Show is next Wednesday and it will be upstairs in the hallway. Cadre 5 & 9 are visiting April 15th to see what we do here and to give us feedback. World Down Syndrome Day is March 21st and we will be selling t-shirts as part of our ESE program.
