Budget: Maryanne Cockerille: Total \$66,627; \$15,000 is held in restricted funds; \$51,513 is for HSA use; \$29,000 is income from fundraisers so far this year. Pennies for Harbordale/Change Challenge: \$3,213. Pumpkin Pizzazz: \$18,390. We benefitted from lots of donations. Expenses:

\$48,000 (based on money raised last year + \$12,000 we already gave for computers). We already paid close to \$41,000 out to the school and teachers already this year.

Principal's Update: Mrs. Bucolo: Ms. Rodriguez was selected as a finalist for teacher of the year. She had to create a lesson and was observed by the team. Beacon TV is coming today to film her, then she will interview and do a photo shoot. We are very proud of Ms. Rodriguez and her accomplishments. Thank you for Pumpkin Pizzazz. It was the busiest ever. Thanks to Nicki Caruso for arranging free police officers. We can't plan it a week earlier. Sand in playground has been replaced. We can't get rid of the sand because alternatives are very expensive, and we aren't allowed to use woodchips. Veterans Day flags are out. Barnes & Noble Night is run by Kindergarten teachers. Smart Bond: We are in the midst of getting all quotes (curtains, marquis and technology) and getting bids. Everything should be complete by Jan/Feb. Food drive: 800 items collected; Mrs. Bureau works with our own families to donate. Toy Drive: we will donate to outside organizations as well as our own families. Christmas on Las Olas: We've participated for 35 years. Performance will be on stage by Cheesecake factory at 6pm. Parking will be difficult. Show will be repeated on Dec. 18th at 8:30am at school.
