- We have a total of \$64,000
 - \$13,051 is in restricted (Adopt A Class and carryover from last year)
- World Down Syndrome Day \$15
- Total is \$50,515 for the HSA

- Lunch is adjusted today to watch the inauguration
- Marquee - Awaiting the installation in early Feb. The installation could impede on arrival/ dismissal, we will work around. It will help communications.
- Magnets and Reassignments are due 2/8
- Runaway Bay - Do not block the driveway
- I-Ready Diagnostic tests for 2nd-5th replaces the BSA except 5th grade will take the BSA Science the 1st week of Feb.
- AR is in full swing - Ms. Gordon gave prizes to all students who made their goal
- FSA is a go. I do not know if this will affect the school grades
 - April - 3rd grade Reading, 4th and 5th Writing
 - May - Reading for 4th and 5th, then Math and Science
 - Books were purchased
 - Parent training with Ms. Gordon next Tues at 8:30am through Teams
 - FSA virtual students must be present at school

-2nd and 3rd grades in the process of making changes. Parents have been called to notify them if their child will be changed. They have 24 hours to decide if they want their child sent back to school or stay virtual. All students on campus together in class, all kids virtually will be in the same class.

- Friday the 3rd grade will be changed
- Next week will be 2nd
- 4th and 5th can not be changes at this time
- Quarantine - the entire class will move online
 - if 1 or 2 students need to quarantine they will move to the online teacher for the duration of their quarantine then return back to the face to face teacher after
- An entire class exposure, the entire class is home for 2 weeks
- Any child flagged by teacher parents need to sign a document acknowledging they still want to keep them home instead of face to face
- Currently we have 150 students at home, 470 total, original projection was 506 total
- 320 students on campus - 6ft Covid protocols
- Grades 2/3 eat outside, 4th by the stage, 5th grade in the music room, 5 students to a table
- Come on campus everyone gets sanitizer, no one gets through the fence without a mask.
- Tuesday the mister company comes to mist the whole campus. On Thursday Chad does it.
- The governor encouraged students to come back but parents still have choices
